For anyone interested in doing a home improvement project on a budget, the ReStore is the place to go. It is a wonderful lesson on sustainability and recycling. If it weren't for the ReStore most of these items would have ended up in landfills.

Warehouse: Come to our warehouse to see the behind the scenes work that goes into our houses. We have a paint palace where all of the paints for our houses are mixed, and we have a woodshop where we build various parts of our houses. During the tour of the warehouse, youth will get to see the tools and materials that go into making a house!
