WHAT CAN THE RESTORE ACCEPT?

Appliances – Working Or Not. Pickup not available for non-working unless other items are donated with it Refrigerators, Ovens, Washing Machines, Dryers, Dishwashers, Range Tops, Microwaves, Range Hoods, Small appliances (e.g.: toasters, blenders, etc.), Water Heaters, Furnaces, Air Conditioners, TV's (\$10 recycling fee for TVs more than 5 years old or dysfunctional TVs)

Furniture

Sofas*, Chairs* (living room, office, recliner, etc.), Tables (dining room, side), Dressers, Bedframes, Coffee/End Tables, Entertainment Centers, Filing Cabinets, Bookshelves.

*Upholstered furniture cannot have any stains, tears, or pet damage.

Building Materials

Doors, Full Sheets of Plywood, New Insulation, Lumber (6' minimum, no nails or screws), Trim, Brick/block, Fencing, Exotic Hardwoods

Home Decor

Art, Statues, Antiques, Vases, Dishes, Glassware, Baskets, Knickknacks, Books

Cabinets

Kitchen Cabinets, Bathroom Cabinets, Countertops – only with cabinets (unless they are granite countertops) *All Cabinets must be complete with all cabinet doors and void of major stains and defects

Lighting (must work!)

Hanging Chandeliers, Floor/Table Lamps, Lamp shades in good condition, Ceiling Fans (complete with all parts), Can Lighting

Hardware & Tools

Hinges, Cabinet knobs, Door knobs/deadbolts, Electrical Hardware, Plumbing Hardware, Hand & Power Tools

Plumbing Supplies

Toilets*, Sinks/Faucets*, Tubs*, Pipes

*We cannot accept anything with chips, cracks or stains

Paint & Paint Supplies

Usable Paint & Stain* (3/4 Full or More), Paint Sprayers, Unused brushes, rollers

*We cannot accept industrial/commercial grade product

Flooring

Tile (New & Unbroken Only), Linoleum (New), Carpet (New or Gently Used, Minimum Room-size, no small pieces unless carpet tiles), Wood (Nails Removed), Area rugs (new or gently used)

Windows

Double Hung*, Picture*, Bay (complete with all sashes)*, Stained Glass, Antique Wood (pre-WW2), Wooden Shutters *Windows must be aluminium clad or vinyl replacement only. No broken glass.

Miscellaneous Items

Game tables, Boats, Jet Ski's, RVs

We DO NOT accept items that are:

Not in good working condition, broken or damaged, excessively stained or dirty, hazardous waste, industrial supplies, mattresses or box springs, used cleaning supplies, pesticides, storm windows or sashes, used blinds. Please help us keep waste removal costs down by following these donation criteria.

WHAT WE CAN RECYCLE?

Clothing

Used clothing, coats, gloves, hats, scarves, belts, purses, wallets, ties, shoes, sandals, and fashion accessories including jewelry

Books & Media

Hard and soft cover books, DVDs, and CDs

Housewares

Dishes, glasses, bowls, platters, silverware, utensils, pots, pans, small appliances, hair dryers, curling irons, shavers, coffee makers, blenders, toasters, linens and towels

Toys & Sports Equipment

Dolls, figurines, small toys, balls, bats, gloves

We cannot accept items that are broken, contaminated, not working, nor have missing pieces.
