Donation Center

- Oversee work within donation center including: sold, storage, repair, scrap, and dumpster areas.
- Ensure the movement of donations by properly loading/unloading, cleaning and pricing for sales floor.
- Frequently and safely lift and maneuver furniture, appliances, and building material weighing 75 pounds or more.
- Ensure items are placed in the correct department and merchandised appropriately.
- Oversee selection and pricing of collectible items in-store and on-line.

- Work on sales floor.
