Milwaukee Habitat for Humanity received funding for a Milwaukee Healthy Homes Program grant through the City of Milwaukee Environmental Collaboration Office and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes.



The goal of this program is to help make homes safer and healthier by decreasing risks related to moisture, health and building code issues, and contaminants (radon gas, lead paint, asbestos, and asthma triggers).

Once the completed application and supplemental documents are received, Milwaukee Habitat for Humanity will work with a contractor to conduct a Healthy Homes Assessment, determine if your property is eligible and what repairs can be covered by the grant.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Home must be owner occupied in the City of Milwaukee
- Household income must be within Milwaukee Habitat's income guidelines of 80% AMI and below (see chart below)
- Home must have homeowners' insurance coverage
- Property taxes must be current
- Property cannot be at risk of foreclosure

Household Income Guidelines

8	\$116,900 (\$9,742/month)
